### PREFACE

The **Stichting** NIDOS, the Dutch national guardianship institution for unaccompanied and separated children having more than 30 years of experience in that field, is organizing a virtual **training** with the aim to improve existing practices and build the knowledge of **child professionals** who work in SIL or who are setting up SIL.

*The training is implemented under the auspices of the project **PROUD**, with the main objective to promote Supported Independent Living (SIL) as an alternative care practice for unaccompanied third country national minors aged 15-18.*

*In this project, a guide and a training for professionals have been developed, focusing on improving the knowledge, skills, and abilities of care professionals working in SIL or willing to work in SIL. Therefore, the training focuses on awareness on the pedagogical needs of the child professionals and the skills that are required when working with UAC.*
